In 2009 Earth Liberation Front activist Marius Mason was sentenced to twenty-two years on thirteen counts of arson and property damage targeting a research lab engaged in the genetic modification of plants; logging equipment; suburban homes under construction; and a mink farm operation. The sentence is completely out of proportion to the 'crimes' committed (there was no loss of life), but it reflects the lengths to which the United States' (in)justice system will go to repress the defence of Mother Earth. Marius has penned a poem, *Lion*, that speaks to being caged by the State and the inculcated denial of our natural being that makes this caging possible:

I have been a lion on the plains of Africa Matching sinew against sinew, Timing, speed, all considerations In the meditation of the possible Measuring the balance, Risk and resource, Gain and gamble, Life and death. Now I am a lion on a fabricated rock, Dozing in and out of dreams Golden eyes reflecting faces Indolent and gazing, They at me, Me at them, Shadows of ourselves No longer wild.
